AIM and GS1 have signed a formal working agreement for AIM to develop and publish Specifications for a Sensor Application Identifier (AI) for use within the GS1 System and are looking for volunteers to assist in this project.

The [Sensor AI Working Group](#) will be led by Dr. Clive Hohberger, Sprague Ackley and Ray Delnicki, members of both the AIM Technical Symbolology Committee (TSC) as well as the GS1 Bar Code ID Committee.

Work is expected to begin the week of February 19th and be done entirely through WebEx meetings. This is an ad hoc commitment expected to be convened as necessary.
