Take I-90 West / Kennedy Expy / O'Hare-Rockford exit onto Kennedy Expy W (I-90 W, I-94 W).

Keep left onto Kennedy Expy West (I-90 W) (partial toll road) at exit #43B toward O'Hare-Rockford.

Take the I-290/IL-53/West Suburbs/Northwest Suburbs exit toward IL-53 North/Northwest Suburbs/IL-62/ Algonquin Road.

Turn right onto Algonquin Road (IL-62).

Turn left onto N Meacham Road.

Turn right onto Tower Road.

Turn left onto National Parkway.
