**Project Description:** Collect, bag, and remove trash/debris from the bank of Potomac River bordering Fort Foote National Park

**About Site:** Supported by the National Capital Park Service (NCPS) and The Greater Fort Foote Area Recreational, Cultural, and Historical Council, Inc., Fort Foote was constructed in 1863 atop Rozier's Bluff to strengthen the ring of fortifications that encircled Washington, D.C. Two of the Guns that protected Washington are still there along with the remains of the fort's earthworks.

**Directions to Site:** Fort Foote is located on the Potomac River in Prince Georges County.

From the Beltway (I-95), take Exit 3 (Indian Head Highway) south (MD210)

Drive for approximately 3.5 miles to Old Fort Road

Turn right for one mile to Fort Foote Road South

Turn left

Follow the winding road through the residential area to the entrance sign on the left for the Fort
