Things you should bring: All volunteers should come prepared to work and abide by the following

- Volunteers should dress comfortably, preferably in jeans, t-shirts and/or sweatshirts. Volunteers work in the warehouse where the temperature may vary depending on the season. Tennis shoes or boots should be worn. No open-toe shoes of any kind are allowed in the warehouse.
- Volunteers must be at least 18 years old.
- Volunteers must be able to lift up to 25 lbs. without assistance.
- Volunteers should expect to be standing and mobile for a minimum of 3 hours in order to move, sort and load products and packages.
