About Site: Rain Gardens are one of the best practices for storm water management. Rain Gardens both reduce flooding and pollution while adding an attractive feature to yards. It is a way for each homeowner to take responsibility for the storm water that falls on their property. A rain garden is a shallow, bowl-shaped garden that collects rain water for a day or two, reducing flooding and filtering pollution out of the water. On average, they are about 150 square feet and 18 inches deep.
