Rose Summit parking lot to Galena Waterfall needs significant work to bring it back up to standard by clearing downed trees, repairing trail tread, fixing signage. **Volunteers should be prepared to engage in physical work at 10,000 feet of elevation.**

About Site: Central to the mission of the Tahoe Rim Trail Association is the maintenance and enhancement of the 165 mile trail itself. Each year the Trail Operations Program's staff, crew leaders, and volunteers devote thousands of hours to clearing downed trees, repairing trail tread, fixing signage and building new trails and trail connections on the Tahoe Rim Trail. Working cooperatively with the US Forest Service and other trail partners, the TRTA works to maintain a safe, sustainable and fun trail system.
