### ***The Bledisloe Medal***

The Bledisloe Medal, initiated in 1930 by the late Viscount Bledisloe, former Governor-General of New Zealand, is awarded to a former student or past or current staff member of Lincoln University who, in the opinion of the Lincoln University Council, has made an outstanding contribution in his or her chosen field, advanced New Zealand's interests, and/or brought credit to Lincoln University.

### ***Award Criteria***

The Nominee will be assessed on the following criteria:

- they are a former student or past or current staff member of Lincoln University who has made an outstanding contribution in his or her chosen field and/or brought credit to Lincoln University
- their achievements in his/her career;
- the economic, scientific, cultural or technological value of the nominee's work;
- the extent of the connection between the work of the nominee and the aims/interests of Lincoln University;
- the extent to which the nominee's achievements reflect on, or have the potential to reflect on, the University's reputation; and
- the extent to which the candidate's achievements have advanced New Zealand's Interests.
