The candidate will teach developmental courses through upper division mathematics courses. The College seeks a candidate who places emphasis on student learning and student success as top priorities. The candidate is also expected to represent the College credibly with respect to any of its activities, and observe, support, and enforce the regulations, policies, and programs of the College.
