The College is seeking a Mathematics Instructor with a Master's degree in Mathematics or a Master's degree with 18 graduate semester hours in Mathematics. College level teaching experience is preferred. Familiarity with online homework systems is also preferred. Courses to be taught include Intermediate Algebra, College Algebra, Mathematics for Liberal Arts I, Mathematics for Liberal Arts II, Elementary Statistics, and Developmental Mathematics; possibly Precalculus and Calculus. Minimum teaching load is 15-18 contact hours per week, including one evening class during both the fall and spring semesters. Full-time faculty must hold a minimum of 10 on campus office hours per week to confer with students. Teaching duties will be on both the Palatka and St. Augustine Campuses. Opportunities for overloads and summer employment is based on student demand.

In order to be considered, upload the following documents with your application: (1) transcripts for all colleges attended, (2) a curriculum vitae that includes the institutions where you've worked and the courses you've taught, (3), a syllabus of a relevant course you have recently taught, and (4) a letter to the search committee describing your teaching experience.

Applicant must pass verification of employment/reference screening and a background check. This is a full-time, nine-month position, starting August 2018.
