

ABA Member Center Logging In

To log in to the member center:

Step 1: Click on the member center menu link on the ABA homepage, or go to <http://ameriburn.site-ym.com>.

Step 2: Enter your username and password in the left hand columns. Your username is typically your email address or your first initial and last name. If you can't remember your password, click on the "Forgot your password" link and follow instructions to reset your password.
