

BUFFALO RIFLE MATCH

A slow fire match, shot at 200 yards on an mr63 target, designed to get those old rifles out and any modern ones that shoot the same old cartridges.

You will have 45 minutes to fire 30 shots for score and 5 sighters, 15 rounds prone and 15 rounds sitting or kneeling.

Sighters do not have to be taken all at once. You may shoot 1 or 2 and save the rest for sitting. Just let your scorer know how you are proceeding.

If you cannot shoot prone, you may shoot the whole match sitting or kneeling.

Shooting jackets, gloves, mats, spotting scopes are allowed. You may use a sling or shooting sticks [shooting sticks have two legs, not one or three] No sand bags or rests allowed.

This match is for IRON SIGHT rifles only, no optics or red dots.

We are looking for big slow bullets .38 caliber and larger, lead or copper jacketed, smokeless or black power loads.

There will be 3 relays per target. A shooter, a scorer, and a target puller.
Coaching is allowed.

Eye and ear protection must be worn while in the pits and on the firing line.
