

SCHOLARSHIPS FOR ASA EARLY CAREER SCIENTISTS AND GRADUATE AND UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS IN THE SCIENCES AND ENGINEERING

A number of members have graciously provided funding for a limited number of scholarships. Scholarships are available to early career and student ASA members on a first-come, first-served basis.

TWO LEVELS OF SCHOLARSHIP

1. For those giving an oral or poster presentation and attending the entire meeting: Scholarships will cover *100% of on-campus housing (double occupancy) and meals* at the conference. See Call for Abstracts for abstract submission details.
2. For those not giving an oral or poster presentation but are attending the entire meeting: Scholarships will cover *75% of on-campus housing (double occupancy) and meals* at the conference.

BENEFITS OF ATTENDING THE CONFERENCE

- This meeting provides an opportunity to meet professionals in your field who share your Christian faith; to hear prominent plenary speakers; to participate in the oral sessions; to give an oral or poster presentation yourself; to network and fellowship with other Christians from a wide variety of colleges, universities, and research institutions; and to explore how to integrate your faith with your discipline.
- The ASA Annual Meeting will provide an excellent opportunity for you to share your research with Christian colleagues.
- Your oral or poster presentation can be listed on your résumé as being presented at a professional meeting; it can strengthen your applications for further training, grants, or career advancement.

HOW TO APPLY FOR A SCHOLARSHIP

- If you are already a Student member, the registration costs are waived. To apply for a scholarship covering room and board, sign in to the ASA [website](#) and complete the online scholarship [application](#).
- If you are not a Student member, you need to complete the online ASA membership application by going to [Membership](#) → Join ASA. Then apply for a room-and-board scholarship as noted in the bullet above.
