



Eligibility for Membership in ASM

ASM offers two categories of membership – **Subcontractor Membership** and **Associate Membership**, for providers of supplies or services to subcontractors. Please read below for an understanding of the criteria for membership, from the ASM Bylaws (Article V, Section 1).

SUBCONTRACTOR MEMBERS: Any person, firm, partnership or corporation lawfully, substantially and primarily engaged in the business of subcontracting or specialty contracting by both furnishing labor and installing materials or furnishing labor and equipment for installing materials for construction contract work may apply for Membership. All applications for Membership shall be subject to the review and recommendation of the Membership Committee, and final consideration and approval or rejection by the Board of Directors.

ASSOCIATE MEMBERS: Any person, firm, partnership or corporation lawfully and substantially engaged in the business of providing to subcontractors or specialty contractors supplies or services, including but not limited to construction materials, tools or equipment, bonding or insurance, safety or risk management services, financial or banking services, marketing or communication services or payroll or human resource services, may apply for Associate Membership. All applications for Associate Membership shall be subject to the review and recommendation of the Membership Committee and final consideration and approval or rejection by the Board of Directors. Associate Members will pay dues established by the Board, will receive copies of publications, may attend general membership meetings, may serve on committees, and otherwise participate fully in the activities and services of the Association.

In addition to the foregoing, any application for membership shall be approved only if the applicant is deemed a person who, or firm, partnership or corporation which, shall serve to advance the purposes of the Association. Approval of any application for membership is within the discretion of the Board of Directors and any such application may be denied for any lawful reason.
