### Craig Levy, MS Epizoologist, Maricopa County Department of Public Health, Office of Epidemiology

Craig Levy is currently the Epizoologist at the Maricopa County Department of Public Health (MCDPH) in Phoenix, Arizona (since July 2011). Prior to working at the MCDPH, Craig worked for nearly 28 years at the Arizona Department of Health Services (ADHS) in the Vector-Borne and Zoonotic Diseases (VBZD) Program. From 1983 – 1993 he worked as an epidemiologist in the ADHS-VBZD Program, and from 1993-2011, he was the program manager. Craig received his Bachelor of Science Degree from Colorado State University (CSU) in 1979 and his Masters of Science Degree in Zoology at Arizona State University (ASU) in 1983.

Sally Ann Iverson is a veterinarian in the Epidemic Intelligence Service through the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention serving in the US Public Health Service.
