PROGRAM OVERVIEW

LENGTH OF PROGRAM: 8 months part-time

ACADEMIC PREREQUISITES

- Graduation with a minimum of second class standing from an accredited, baccalaureate-granting University;
- A baccalaureate or Master's degree in a healthcare profession;
- A statement of interest in the program;
- Curriculum vitae; and
- 2 references: 1 academic and 1 professional.

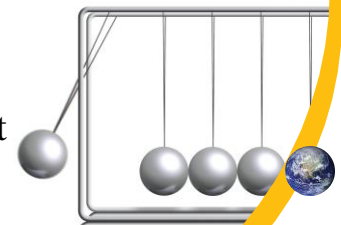
METHOD OF COMPLETION
