THE NEED FOR HOME HEALTH IS EXPLODING.

Over **20,400** enrollees in the CT Home Care Program for Elders (CHCPE) are receiving home health services – a number projected to nearly double by 2020.

HOME HEALTH FOCUSES ON AN INDIVIDUAL'S RECOVERY.

Highly-skilled nurses assess and manage serious mental illnesses – care that saves Connecticut an additional **\$25 million** per year.

MORE AGING IN PLACE = MORE STATE SAVINGS.

The average monthly expense for Department of Social Services CHCPE participants has dropped by over **25%** in the last 6 years and **10-22%** for 2013-2016.

THE HOME HEALTH WORKFORCE IS AN ECONOMIC ENGINE.

Over **19,000** workers are employed by licensed Connecticut home health and hospice agencies, one of the only growing sectors in the state.
