Ambassador - The person who establishes and owns the engagement/s with the school or organization. Responsibilities include:

1. Approach and provide program information so that the school contact can make a decision. (Tools: Cyber Security Challenge NW Welcome Letter and Flyer)
2. Work with school contact to determine the topics allowed during presentation.
3. Suggest classroom sessions where possible (instead of assembly) for presentations.
4. Gain media presentation requirements (projector, screen, etc).
5. Provide the following information to IRM Scheduling to set engagement date/s.

- Name of Group
- Contact Name, Phone, Email
- Exact Address for mapquesting
- Number of Sessions Wanted: _____ # of Students per Session

4. Meet with assigned Lead Presenter to
 - confirm content
 - confirm scheduled appointment/s and
 - confirm media requirements
 - determine handouts or trinkets and request from appropriate area
5. Confirm engagement with school contact one week before appointment.
6. Attend initial engagement. Help set up presentation and facilitate introductions.
7. Continue to manage engagements with school until all are concluded.
8. Assess school satisfaction level and recommend improvements to IRM team as appropriate.
