~ Over \$1 million worth of scholarships available to Florida high school seniors and G.E.D. recipients to further their education ~

TALLAHASSEE, FL - - The Florida Association of Postsecondary Schools and Colleges (FAPSC), in partnership with member schools and colleges throughout Florida, is now accepting applications for its 2010 FAPSC Scholarship program. The deadline for students to submit their applications, essays and transcripts is April 9, 2010. Last year, FAPSC awarded scholarships worth more than \$600,000 to students seeking to further their educational goals. **Over \$1 million worth of scholarships are available to Florida high school seniors and G.E.D. recipients for future education.**

FAPSC coordinates a program that offers more than 500 scholarships each year to graduating high school seniors and G.E.D. recipients pursuing postsecondary education at many Florida's leading private career schools and colleges. These scholarships range in amounts from \$1,000 to \$5,000 to full tuition, for programs ranging from short-term diploma programs to four-year college degree programs.

These scholarships would not be possible if it was not for the generosity of these FAPSC member schools.
