

Shawn Hodges is a pharmacist and owner of Innovation Compounding. He graduated with a Doctorate in Pharmacy from Texas Tech University School of Pharmacy. Upon graduation, he was awarded a one-year fellowship program with Eli Lilly, where he researched the FDA regulatory affairs framework as well as the drug approval process. Since his fellowship, Shawn has counseled healthcare practitioners across the country about the important role that pharmacy compounding serves, ranging from therapeutic options for terminally-ill hospice patients, to dosing strategies for women's hormone therapy, and presenting evidence of non-narcotic pain drugs as an alternative to opioid medications.

Shawn's pharmacy practice is an ACHC/PCAB accredited compounding-only pharmacy that compounds both sterile and non-sterile preparations. Shawn sits on the International Academy of Compounding Pharmacists (IACP) Board of Directors, is a member of IACP's legislative committee, and is also Chairman of the IACP COMP PAC Committee.
