Hon. Thomas J. Felts inducted as chair-elect of ISBA House of Delegates

INDIANAPOLIS (Oct. 23, 2014) – Hon. Thomas J. Felts, Fort Wayne, has been inducted as chair-elect of the House of Delegates of the Indiana State Bar Association (ISBA) at its annual meeting in Indianapolis. His term will expire in October 2015, after which he will become chair.

Hon. Thomas J. Felts is judge of the Allen Circuit Court. Previously, he served as a magistrate for the court and was an associate, then partner at the firm Burt Blee Dixon Sutton & Bloom. Judge Felts received his B.A. from the University of Notre Dame in 1976 and his J.D. from the I.U. Maurer School of Law in 1979. He is a member of the Allen County and Indiana State bar associations.

Judge Felts currently serves as a member of the boards of directors for the Allen County Courthouse Preservation Trust, Indiana Judges Association, Allen County Community Corrections, Foellinger Foundation, Indiana Judicial Conference and the St. Joseph Community Health Foundation. He is also a member of the Indiana General Assembly Interim Committee on Courts and the Judiciary.
