Michael Dalrymple appointed as Indiana State Bar Association secretary

INDIANAPOLIS (Oct. 28, 2014) – Michael S. Dalrymple, Indianapolis, was appointed as secretary of the Indiana State Bar Association (ISBA) at its annual meeting in on Oct. 10. He was appointed by ISBA President Jeff R. Hawkins and his term will expire in October 2015.

Dalrymple is a solo practitioner, representing individuals and small businesses in employment and labor law, discrimination, corporate matters, and estate planning. He also is a civil mediator, providing mediation services for a variety of civil matters. Prior to opening his own law firm, Dalrymple was an associate at Ice Miller. Immediately following law school, he was appointed to a two-year judicial clerkship, spending his first year with Hon. Sanford M. Brook, former chief judge of the Indiana Court of Appeals, and his second year with Hon. Randall T. Shepard, former Indiana chief justice. He earned his B.A. from Earlham College and his J.D. from the I.U. Maurer School of Law. He also attended the London Law Consortium Program and was elected student graduation speaker.

Dalrymple is a member of the Indiana State Bar Association, U.S. District Court for the Southern District of Indiana Local Rules Advisory Committee and is a former member of the American Inn of Court. He is active in numerous performing arts and community development organizations and currently serves on the board of the Indiana School for the Blind and Visually Impaired. He also regularly presents and provides training on disability-related topics.
