

1989 ITAA Fellow – Charlotte Bennett



Charlotte M. Bennett, Vice President for University Advancement, Dean of the College of Home Economics, Assistant Director of Agricultural Experiment Station, North Dakota State University, has been a nominee for the 1986 Fargo-Moorhead YWCA Woman of the Year, has received a “Women to Watch” recognition by the *Fargo-Moorhead Area Women Magazine* (Winter 1986), and was listed in *Who’s of American Women*. She has served as National and Central Region ACPTC President, on major committees of the Nation Association of Land Grant Colleges and Universities, and the Experiment Station Committee on Policy representing Home Economics.

Charlotte Bennett died September 9, 1991. She was 48. She earned her master’s at Louisiana State University and her doctorate at Indiana University. She joined the NDSU faculty in 1981 as Associate Dean for Research and Graduate Programs for the College of Home Economics and Assistant Director of the Agricultural Experiment Station. In 1982, she became Dean of the college.
