

1999 ITAA Fellow – Jane Farrell-Beck



Jane Farrell-Beck held several ITAA committee appointments, including Fellowship Committee, Publications Committee, Conference Evaluation Committee; she also was Associate Editor for History and Cultural Research for *Clothing and Textiles Research Journal*. In 1998, she was chosen to deliver the Distinguished Scholar Lecture at ITAA's annual meeting.

Farrell-Beck has written or co-written 32 journal articles, in *Dress, Clothing and Textiles Research Journal, Journal of the History of Medicine and Allied Sciences, International Journal of Dermatology, Nursing History Review, and Textile History*. She was co-author with Geitel Winakor on *The History of Costume, from Mesopotamia through the Twentieth Century*, 2<sup>nd</sup> Ed. Other books include *Uplift: the Bra in America* with Colleen Gau and *20<sup>th</sup>- Century Dress in the United States*, with Jean Parsons. Her Iowa State University students appreciated her “genuine and contagious enthusiasm” in the classes she taught. Jane retired as Professor Emerita in 2003.

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
