Quick Reference Guide

ROLE

The AWWA Director of the KY/TN Section AWWA is proudly responsible for assisting the Section Chair in the leadership, guidance and implementation of the mission of the Section; as it pertains to the vision, mission, core principles, and strategic goals and objectives of the Section and the Association. Represents the Section at the Association level. The AWWA Director is a voting member of both the AWWA Board of Directors and the Section Board of Trustees.

Responsibilities:

1. Attend all meetings of the AWWA Board of Directors, taking actions in accordance with the instructions received from the Section Board of Trustees and, where no instructions prevail, take action as, in his or her considered opinion, is in the best interests of the water utility profession and in particular the profession's interest in the KY/TN Section.
2. Attend all Board of Trustees meetings and the Annual Water Professionals Conference (WPC) business meetings giving a formal written and/or verbal report on the pertinent actions of the AWWA Board of Directors.
3. Submit a written report of each AWWA Director's meeting to the Board of Trustees.
4. Serve as host for the AWWA official representative(s) visiting the WPC.
5. Serve as Board Liaison to the Fuller Award Committee.
