ROLE

The Knowledge Exchange Council (KEC) Chair of the KY/TN Section AWWA is proudly responsible for assisting the Section Chair in the leadership, guidance and implementation of the mission of the Section; as it pertains to the vision, mission, core principles, and strategic goals and objectives of the Section and the Association. Represents the KEC on the Board of Trustees.

Responsibilities:

1. Oversee the creation, development, facilitation, and marketing of training courses and other knowledge resources for water utility personnel and all other members in each of the two states.
2. Serve as Board Liaison to the Customer Service, Safety, Water Distribution & Storage, and Water Quality & Plant Operations Committees. (Refer to Board Liaison *Quick Reference Guide* for list of responsibilities.)
3. Review, evaluate, and update the KEC Bylaws.
4. Attend and participate in Section Board meetings and conference calls, and the Fall Leadership Retreat.
5. Work closely with Environmental Protection Agency officials, State Regulatory Agencies and Boards of Certification in both states, and other water industry organizations to determine the training needs of Section membership.
6. Work with AWWA and other water industry organizations in collaborative training.
7. Work with Section staff to facilitate training programs and knowledge resources in both Kentucky and Tennessee.
