Quick Reference Guide

ROLE

The Manufacturers and Associates Council (MAC) Chair of the KY/TN Section AWWA is proudly responsible for assisting the Section Chair in the leadership, guidance and implementation of the mission of the Section; as it pertains to the vision, mission, core principles, and strategic goals and objectives of the Section and the Association. Represents the MAC on the Board of Trustees.

Responsibilities:

1. Provide responsible representation for those Section members who generally include manufacturers, suppliers, consultants, and contractors. Provide for involvement of Service Provider Members in the Section.
2. Develop programs and activities for Service Provider Members. Encourage their membership and participation in the Section.
3. Ensure positive productive liaison between member's interests and the common goals and objectives of the Section.
4. Review, evaluate, and update the MAC Bylaws.
5. Serve as Board Liaison to the Engineering Design & Construction, Small Systems, Non-Revenue Water, and Utility Finance Management Committees. (Refer to Board Liaison *Quick Reference Guide* for list of responsibilities.)
6. Hold an initial organizational meeting at the Annual Water Professionals Conference (WPC) and at least two additional meetings during the year as required to accomplish the goals and objectives of the committee.
7. Assist WPC Planning Committee with establishing guidelines for the WPC exhibits. Provide and actively promote opportunities for MAC members to demonstrate products and services to membership at the WPC.
8. Provide policy input and develop response and commitment within the framework of the Section on matters affecting Service Provider Members.
9. Attend and participate in Section Board meetings and conference calls and the Fall Leadership Retreat.
