At the last PREP meeting there was discussion regarding probate documents being tracked to land in Olmsted County. I had announced that Olmsted County would no longer be tracking the probate documents to land stated in a subsequent document (i.e. Personal Representative's Deed) within the document package. The reasoning for this was because of the numerous requests we have been receiving, at a later date, to track these probate papers to additional property.

After reviewing this decision with the Olmsted County Attorney's office, it has been determined that we <u>will</u> continue to track probate documents to the land stated in the transfer document following the probate papers.

However, if at a later date you need these probate papers tracked to additional property, you must submit a request to us in writing. Please include document numbers and recording dates of the probate papers you wish the additional land added to in your written request.
