NATURE OF COMMUNICATION	ALWAYS OK	SOMETIMES OK	NEVER OK

8. Using profanity with a participant			
9. Using profanity directed at a participant			
10. Calling a participant at home			
11. Meeting a participant socially out of office or program time			
12. Contacting participants on an office Facebook account			
13. Posting pictures of prevention program activities on an office Facebook account			
14. Posting pictures of prevention program activities on a personal Facebook account			
15. Responding positively to a participant's online "friend" request			
16. "Friending" a participant online			
17. "You're very attractive."			
18. "You are very special to me."			
19. "There are times I forget you are a youth."			
20. "I like you."			
21. "I will always be there for you."
