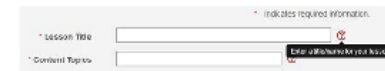

Submitting a Lesson

At the top of each of the sections in the Submission form, you will find a tabbed bar listing the steps for submitting your lesson.



Throughout the submission form, items marked with a red asterisk are required. You will also see a question mark icon, spaced throughout the form. Hovering your mouse over this icon will bring up additional instructional/help text as seen in the image below.



STEP 1: LESSON

The first step of the lesson submission process asks you to supply general information about the lesson:

- Lesson title (name of the lesson)
- Subject matter (i.e. anatomy, verb tense, fractions)
- Description (a short 1-2 sentence description of the lesson)



Throughout the submission process, the inline editor in the form will allow you to format your input much like using any word processor.
