Progress and Effecting Change for Ohio's APRNs

A Call to Action: Education, Policy and Practice Needs YOU!

Angela Golden, DNP, FNP-C

Dr. Golden believes that nurse practitioners are an answer to America's healthcare crisis. During the opening session, she will share how you can help create this answer in health policy, education, and practice as individuals. Come and hear this call to action for each of us!

The Future of NP Practice: FPA as a National Model for Healthcare Delivery

Penny Kaye Jensen, DNP, FNP-C

Dr. Jensen will discuss her difficult and arduous journey in securing Full Practice Authority for APRNs working for the Veterans Administration (VA). The impact of the VA's recognition of full practice authority for all APRNs increases the public visibility of APRNs and helps push for removal of barriers to practice for APRNs across the country.

In her role as liaison for National APRN Policy for the VA Office of Nursing Service (ONS), Dr. Jensen was a leader in the VA initiative that resulted in full practice authority for all VA APRNs (CRNAs were not granted FPA).

8:00 am Basic Suturing

Learn fundamentals of wound evaluation and treatment, wound healing, skin anatomy, type of injury, anesthesia drug selection, blocks, local infiltrate, closure methods, suturing and knot tying, minimizing cosmetic disfigurement, after care and more. This is a hands on workshop with opportunity for individual instruction.

Additional \$25 supply fee for suture kit you take home. Limit 45.

8:00 am Intraarticular and Periarticular Injections

This is a hands-on workshop where you will learn proper intraarticular and periarticular injection techniques. Topics include: common musculoskeletal pathologies and indications for intraarticular and periarticular injection; musculoskeletal anatomy and anatomic landmarks necessary to perform successful intraarticular and periarticular injections; codes for billing and reimbursement; and pharmacological principles of common injectables including local anesthetics and corticosteroids. **Limit 40.**

8:00 am Infectious Diseases

Diagnosis and treatment of infectious diseases including MRSA, Lyme disease, urinary tract infections, C-Diff, and community acquired pneumonia will be discussed. Data, trends, antibiotics, microbiology, adverse reactions, dosing and testing and more will be covered as they relate to these and other infectious diseases.

8:00 am Beginning 12-Lead ECG

This workshop will cover the normal ECG as well as common abnormalities such as axis deviation, hypertrophy, intervals and ischemia/injury/infarct and other ECG changes. We will discuss basic anatomy of the heart and examine how changes to the heart due to various co-morbid conditions can be reflected on the 12-Lead ECG.

1:00 pm Minor Procedures for Primary Care

This hands-on workshop will cover injections of local anesthesia for digital block, abscess incision, drainage indications, procedures for nail removal and more. You will have an opportunity to practice the skills demonstrated. **Limit 50.**

1:00 pm Basic Suturing

Drugs of Addiction: Alcohol and Opioid Pharmacotherapy

8:00 am - 10:00 am

Dr. Chris Paxos and *Dr. Sara Dugan* will open Saturday's program discussing drugs of addiction, including both alcohol use disorder and opioid use disorder which are the most prevalent in the US. This presentation will review tools to identify substance use disorders, medication treatment options for AUD and OUD, and medication-related pearls for treating patients with substance use disorders.

Dr. Chris Paxos is a pharmacotherapy specialist in psychiatric medicine at Cleveland Clinic Akron General.

Dr. Sara Dugan is in the Neurology-Psychiatry module of Pharmacotherapy and Practice of Pharmacy at NEOMED.

Vivitrol Drug Court and Medication Assisted Treatment

Judge Frederick T. Moses of Hocking County and *Amy Black, CNP* will discuss Hocking County's Municipal Drug Court utilizing Vivitrol as a Medication Assisted Therapy (MAT). This creative drug court program reviews the information needed to determine if Vivitrol is the right choice for your patient. The court program, Vivitrol as an MAT, the latest research, pros and cons as well as case studies will be presented.

Judge Frederick Moses established one of the first drug courts in Ohio, currently overseeing two drug courts in rural Southeastern Ohio.

Amy Black, CNP, is a recognized expert in the use of Vivitrol as Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT), is an FNP practicing at the Hopewell Health Center, and is the primary care consultant for the Hocking County Municipal Vivitrol Drug Court Program
