GLOBAL RECOGNITION.

For global recognition, our 64th NATCON will have workshops on how to become ACPE, APEC, ASEAN Engineers. The workshops will be designed so that at the end of the workshop, the attendees will be made to fill-up forms and submit documentary requirement to start the process of the ACPE, APEC and ASEAN Engineers certification/registration.

There will be workshop on how to become a Professional Mechanical Engineer (PME), on professional practice and on implementation of R.A. 8495.

POWER & RENEWABLE ENERGY CONFERENCE (PSME POWERCON).

There will also be a conference on Power and Renewable Energy (PSME POWERCON.) We will be inviting policy makers, industry players, consultants, technical speakers and PHILMACH exhibitors who are from or active in the power and renewable energy to discuss issues affecting the sector. This would also offer career and business opportunities for our delegates.

EARN CPD CREDIT UNITS.

These seminars and plenary speeches offers Continuing Professional Development (CPD) credit units for delegates. This is very important in view of the **full implementation** this year of the CPD (formerly CPE) program of the Professional Regulation Commission (PRC), mandating all those renewing their License to have fifteen (15) CPD credit units per year. Aside from this the Senate Bill 2581 "CPD Act of 2015" has been passed on 3rd reading already. We can expect this to become a law also this year. The bill requires 24 CPD credit units to renew the PRC license.

MORE FUN IN 64th NATCON.

The 64th NATCON is an opportunity to rekindle the bond between friends and between chapters, and to take a break from job related stresses. Thus, the Committees handling the sports and other social events within the 64th NATCON are given their primary objective: **MORE FUN in 64th NATCON!** We will have golf, chess and bowling tournaments.

To celebrate success of our members and chapters, we will have a fellowship night to remember and an awarding ceremony befitting the challenges confronted and hardwork exerted by the honorees.

CHEAPER NATCON FOR DELEGATES.




