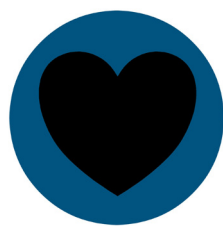

Where: Upper Campus

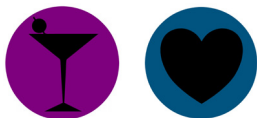
When: October 29, 4 p.m. - 6 p.m.
