



# 2012 National Tasting Project

## Pinot Noir

### Soft, Subtle and Potentially Seductive



The National Tasting Project gives chapter across the US the opportunity to sample the same group of wines in a blind tasting. This year 65 chapters, representing 1,482 tasters in 26 different states participated in the NTP. This represents the largest number of tasters and chapters participating in the event – almost a third of our total membership!

Each participating chapter selected 6 wines from a list of 14, one from each of the following geographical areas: France, California, Oregon, Argentina, Australia and Italy. The wines were tasted blind and scored on the AWS 20-point scale. The results show that

- The 4 California wines garnered the highest scores, with Twomey by Silver Oak and Belle Glos Meiomi as the overall favorites.
- All 4 California wines and 1 of the French wines scored in the AWS silver medal range (15.0-16.9).
- All of the remaining wines scored in the AWS bronze medal range (13.0-14.9).
- Although the highest price wine earned the highest marks, wine price wasn't generally an indication of how well the wine scored.
- For all but 2 wines, the graduate Wine Judges gave the wines higher scores than the people who hadn't completed the training program.

The following table shows the average scores for the participants and the graduate wine judges (WJ). The last 2 columns show the percentage of the chapters that tasted the wine and rated them as the favorite and in the top 3.
