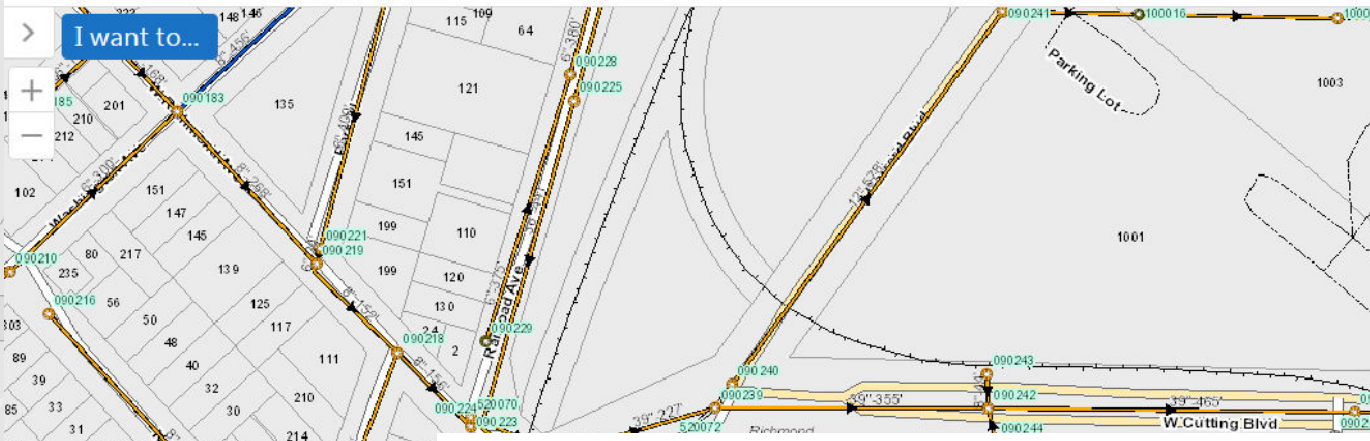


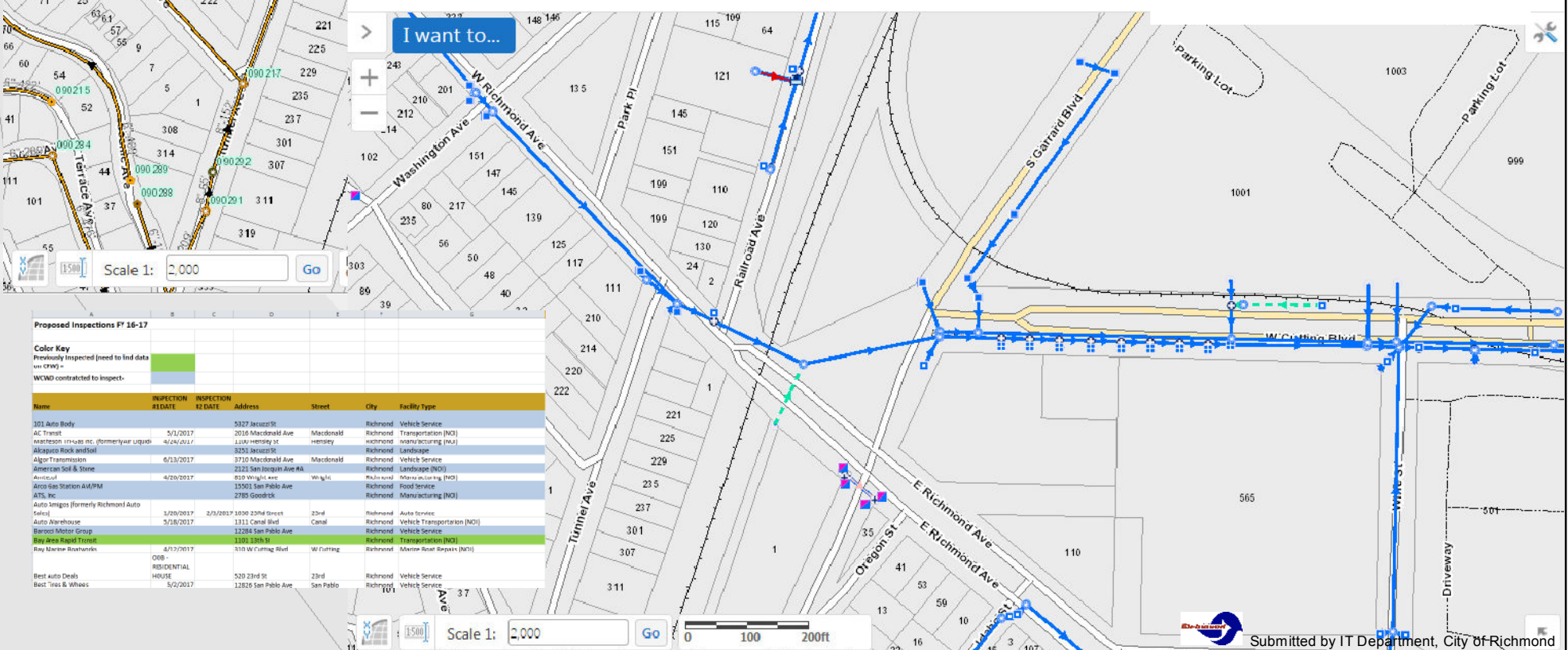
# City of Richmond Sewer and Storm Drain Networks
