

Script Option 1

Hello, my name is _____, and I'm calling to ask **(Senator/Congressperson name)** to protect credit unions in any tax reform proposals that might be considered. The credit union corporate income tax exemption has been in place since 1934 and exists because credit unions are not-for-profit financial cooperatives that are run by members for the benefit of members. Script Option 2

Script Option 3
