# Government Furnished Property What Is It???

“Property in the possession of, or directly acquired by, the Government and subsequently furnished to the contractor for performance of a contract. “



# Government Furnished Property What Is It???

## Vocabulary

- Acquisition – the act of procuring, transferring or fabricating property
- Special Tooling (ST) –Tooling unique to the program
- Special Test Equipment (STE)- Test assemblies and components unique to the program
- ~~Other Plant Equipment (OPE)/Facilities - (computers, etc)~~
- Equipment – a tangible article of personal property that is complete in-and-of itself, durable, non-expendable, and need for the performance of a contract.



# Government Furnished Property What Is It???

## Vocabulary (con't)

- ~~Agency Peculiar Property (APP) – Property unique to the agency~~
- Unique Federal Property – Government –owned personal property that is peculiar to the mission of an agency
- Schedule – When and what will be delivered or produced
- Production – Building of the end product



# Acquisition of Government Property

## ❑ GFP - Government Furnished Property

- ✓ Equipment
- ✓ Information (documents, specifications, software)
- ✓ COMSEC (equipment, keys, software, etc.)

## ❑ CA - Contractor Acquired

- ✓ Property identified in the contract or mod that is required to perform the contract by the contractor
- ✓ Property identified during the performance of the contract and approved ACO. \*\*

**\*\*Note: Contracts under the new rule this does not apply**



# Acquisition of Government

- ❑ Contractor acquires property when
  - ✓ Contract Specifically authorizes it or
  - ✓ Contractor requests authorization from the PCO/ACO\*\*
- ❑ Types of Acquisitions
  - ✓ Purchase: contractor procures the necessary equipment or material.
  - ✓ Fabrication: contractor makes the necessary equipment or tooling.
  - ✓ Furnished: Buying agency provides or procures the required equipment or material.

**\*\*Note: Contracts under the new rule this does not apply**



# Acquisition of Government

- ❑ Government Property - is property acquired (CAP) or furnished (GFP) in the performance of the contract.
- ❑ Title – Property Acquired by the contractor ownership/title passes to the government when its delivered or time of payment by the customer.





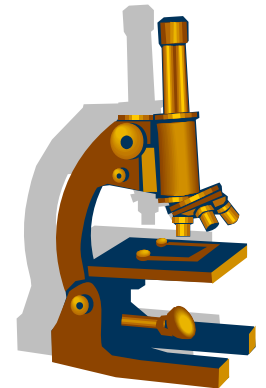
# Government Furnished Property (GFP)



Any item that the **Government (Agency)** decides to furnish the **Contractor**.

## □ Types of GFP

- ✓ Material
- ✓ Equipment
  - Test
  - Plant equipment (Other Plant Equipment, Equipment)
  - Tooling
- ✓ Services (use of facilities or personnel)
- ✓ COMSEC items
- ✓ Buildings
- ✓ Access to Facilities



# Government Furnished Property (GFP)

- ❑ Method of receiving GFP
  - ✓ Transfer of Property from an other government contract
  
  - ✓ Agency provides property
    - Purchasing it from another contractor
    - Or provides it from government stores.
  
  - ✓ Proposals
    - List of available government and required property is submitted during the proposal process
    - When contract is awarded the proposed property list becomes contractual.



# Government Furnished Property (GFP)

## Control of GFP

- ❑ GFP list is contractual
  - ✓ Must be maintained
  - ✓ Tracked
  - ✓ Reported
    - Status
    - Inventories
    - Receipt
  
- ❑ Additions or Deletions require contract modifications
  
- ❑ Extensive GFP lists may require a database to monitor and track.



# Government Furnished Property (GFP)

## Control of GFP (Cont'd)

### □ Status Reporting to Program Management

- ✓ Receipt
- ✓ Meets Contractual Need Dates
  - Meets production requirements
  - Meets production schedule
- ✓ Inventory

### □ Financial Reporting

- ✓ DoD 1662 Property in Possession of Contractors (if required)
- ✓ Identifying all tag items equal too or greater then \$5K
- ✓ Identifying a IUID number
- ✓ Inputting to the Public Registry
- ✓ Maintaining Public Registry information



# Government Furnished Property GFP

## Scheduling, Receipt, Production

- Agency Furnishes
  - ✓COMSEC (hardware, keys and software)
  - ✓Material
  - ✓Equipment (STE, PE (Equipment))
  - ✓Information
  
- Meeting Schedule and Delivery
  
- Meets Form, Fit and Function



# Government Furnished Property (GFP)

## Scheduling, Receipt, Production

- Production Schedule Accurate
  
- Status of Delivery
  - ✓ On time
  - ✓ Early
  - ✓ Late
  
- If Overdue or Slip in Delivery what are the impacts
  - ✓ Production
  - ✓ Schedule
  - ✓ Cost



# Government Furnished Property (GFP)

## Increase in GFP vs. Contractor Acquired

- Many Agency's are providing even more GFP to contractors
  - ✓ Equipment
  - ✓ Material
  - ✓ Parts of the End Product
  
- Contractors dependent on:
  - ✓ Government deliveries
  - ✓ Government Scheduling with suppliers
  - ✓ Equipment meeting form, fit and function
  
- Added Risk
