Seminars Held: 30 plus seminars covering a wide variety of survey related topics held during our annual convention in Flatwoods, WV and various other times and locations during the past year sponsored by various WVSPS local chapters

Items of interest to NSPS: WVSPS signed an MOU with NSPS to become an affiliate participating the NSPS 100% Membership Program. WVSPS is currently corresponding with the WV Department of Labor to investigate and resolve some alleged cases of WVDL Compliance Officers demanding that surveyors present or acquire a contractor's license while providing surveying services on construction projects.

Legislative issues of concern: WVSPS lobbied to pass a ten year statute of limitations on boundary surveying in WV in March 2015. WVSPS is concerned about and currently monitoring legislative activity related to UAV operations.

Causes for NSPS Action: The only actions the WVSPS requests of the NSPS at this time are the normal actions required in response to our recent entry into the NSPS 100% Membership Program. We would also ask for NSPS support, leadership and organizational and strategic guidance in efforts to influence long overdue revisions to the NCEES Model Laws and Model Rules regarding Engineering Surveying.
