PEACEMAKER AWARDS 2016

PURPOSE OF AWARDS

The San Antonio Bar Foundation established the Peacemaker Awards in 1995 to recognize and celebrate the accomplishments of outstanding individuals and companies. Peacemaker Awards 2016 to be presented are:

- (1) **Peacemaker Award:** recognizing an individual or entity who has promoted non-violent resolutions to community conflicts;
- (2) **Corporate Community Service Award:** recognizing a business entity or member of the business community for fostering and performing community service;
- (3) **Carolyn Thurmond Community Service Award:** recognizing a lawyer who has demonstrated outstanding service to our community.

NOMINATION FORMS

MUST BE RECEIVED ON OR BEFORE March 15, 2016. The Foundation will select award recipients in April 2016. The awards will be presented at the 2016 Law Day luncheon. San Antonio Bar Association and Foundation Board of Directors, Judges and Nomination Selection Committee Members are not eligible for the awards.

PEACEMAKER AWARDS 2016

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

Send the following materials, using the guideline below, by March 15, 2016.

A. NOMINATION FORM

The cover page of your nomination materials should be the completed nomination form that follows.

B. NOMINEE'S RESUME

The nominee's resume or biography describing background and contributions.

C. AWARD CRITERIA NARRATIVE AND SUPPORTING MATERIAL

In no more than two typed pages with specific, concrete examples for the following:

- (1) Significant contributions of the nominee relating to the award category.
- (2) Examples of benefits to the community, profession or program relating to the award category due to the nominee's efforts.

You may also include news or magazine articles written by or about the candidate and no more than three letters of support from individuals or organizations. The limitation on letters of support will be observed. If more than three letters are submitted, the Chair of the Nomination Selection Committee will determine which letters will be included with the final nomination materials sent to Nomination Selection Committee members for their review and consideration.

D. PROCEDURAL GUIDELINES

The nomination form and your attachments are the **SOLE** basis for the nomination. **Materials will not be returned.** If possible, the Committee prefers to accept electronically submitted nominations. Please email your completed nominations, including the nomination form and accompanying materials to June Moynihan, SA Bar Foundation Director, at junem@sabar.org. If submitting hard copies, send original and one copy, on 8 ½" x 11" paper. Use paper clips or binder clips. No staples or binding.
