2018 Membership Awards

The Association's membership recognition awards are based on nominations submitted by the membership and selected by the TPA Association Affairs Council. Self-nominations are not accepted. The Council has the sole discretion for selection of the recipients and determination as to whether an award is to be presented. Past recipients are eligible to be repeat recipients. Current officers are not eligible for the Bowl of Hygeia and Pharmacist of the Year awards.

All nominees must be in good standing with the Texas Pharmacy Association and have made contributions to the profession that align with the mission of the Texas Pharmacy Association to enhance and evolve the role of pharmacy in delivering health care solutions and improve patient outcomes.

Bowl of Hygeia

Recognizes a pharmacist who continually has demonstrated professional excellence and made significant public service contributions to their communities. The award is sponsored by the American Pharmacists Association Foundation, the National Alliance of State Pharmacy Associations and Boehringer Ingelheim.

Excellence in Innovation

Recognizes an individual who has demonstrated innovative pharmacy practice resulting in improved patient care and/or advancement of the profession of pharmacy. The award is sponsored by the National Alliance of State Pharmacy Associations and by Upsher-Smith Laboratories, Inc.

Pharmacist of the Year

Recognizes a pharmacist who has made outstanding contributions to the Texas Pharmacy Association and its mission during the past year.

Generation RX Champions

Recognizes an individual, organization or company for education and/or advocacy initiatives around prescription drug abuse. The award is sponsored by Cardinal Health and administered by the Alliance for Patient Medication Safety.

Distinguished Young Pharmacist

Recognizes a pharmacist who has graduated within the last ten years and has demonstrated leadership excellence, made important contributions to their community and the Texas Pharmacy Association, and advanced the practice of pharmacy. The award is sponsored by Pharmacists Mutual.

Distinguished Student Pharmacist

Recognizes a fourth-year pharmacy student who has demonstrated leadership excellence, made important contributions to their community and the Texas Pharmacy Association, and advanced the practice of pharmacy.

Distinguished Pharmacy Technician

Recognizes a pharmacy technician who has demonstrated excellence and supported the advancement of the practice of pharmacy.

Distinguished Service

Recognizes an individual who has provided outstanding service to the pharmacy profession, the health care community and the Texas Pharmacy Association. The recipient does not have to be a pharmacist nor a member of the Association.

Robert L. Hays Outstanding Consultant Pharmacist

Recognizes an individual who has demonstrated excellence in consultant pharmacy practice.

Excellence in Patient Outcomes

Recognizes an organization or company that has made outstanding contributions to advancing pharmacists' ability to improve patient outcomes. This honor recognizes exceptional achievement in public awareness, counseling and pharmacy services aimed at empowering patients to improve their health.
